2021, 2022, & 2023 Tennessee Censorship Legislation

- 2021:
 - <u>Public Chapter 493</u>: first censorship law in TN impacting "prohibited/divisive concepts" in K-12 curriculum and teaching
- 2022:
 - Public Chapter 744: Age Appropriate Materials Act
 - <u>Public Chapter 1137</u>: Textbook Commission; Statewide Book Bans
 Textbook Commission's <u>Library Guidance</u>
 - Public Chapter 818: Higher Education "Divisive Concepts" Restrictions
- 2023:
 - Public Chapter 438: Restrictions on Implicit Bias Training
 - Public Chapter 268: The Higher Education Freedom & Transparency Act
 - Public Chapter 448: Student Pronouns Restrictions
 - <u>Public Chapter 285</u>: Private School Regulations on Sports Participation

Promising Momentum

- Chalkbeat TN (2023): <u>Teachers sue over Tennessee law restricting what they can teach about</u>
 <u>race, gender, and bias</u>
- Chalkbeat TN (2024): <u>Teachers can challenge Tennessee law restricting instruction on race,</u> <u>gender, bias, judge rules</u>

2024 Legislative Wins

- <u>HB1414 / SB0620:</u> Families' Rights & Responsibilities Act
- HB1661/ SB2173: Restricted Access by Minors to Obscene Library Materials Act
- <u>SB2107/HB2457</u>: Sexually Explicit Materials Restrictions
- HB1660/SB2351: Anti-Discrimination and Protected Classes (Higher Ed)
- HB1948/SB2350: Dismantling Diversity, Equity & Inclusion (DEI) in Higher Ed
