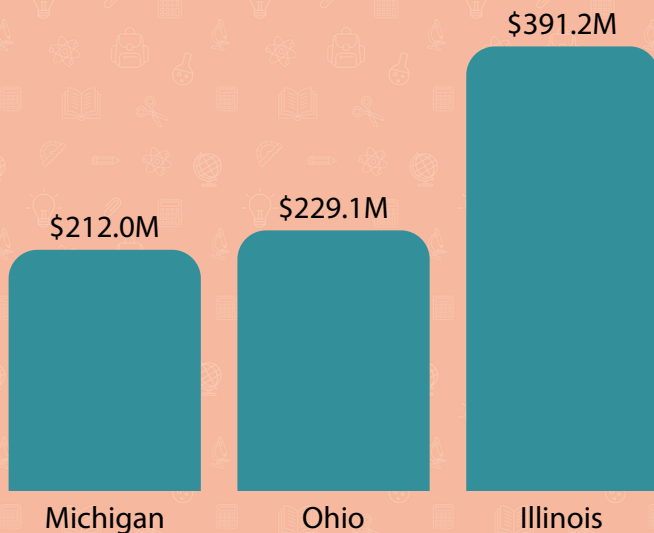


What Happens When Grad PLUS Loans Disappear in Michigan?

While Michigan's share of Grad PLUS recipients is lower than other states, the concentration of borrowing at a small number of flagship institutions makes the potential impact significant. That support is now at risk, with changes to student loan options taking effect on July 1.

Who Stands to Lose the Most From Grad PLUS Changes?

Public institutions account for the majority of Grad PLUS dollars disbursed in Michigan. Private not-for-profit schools only make up one-third of the total, whereas in other states they often account for over fifty percent.

The elimination of Grad PLUS would disproportionately affect students at large research universities, many of whom are pursuing advanced degrees in professional and STEM fields.
